What Will You Receive?

I get comments from members stating that they do not want mail to or from certain countries. On the other hand, sometimes some members only want covers from a certain country.

If you want covers from a certain country, tell our OMs by using their form 10 or sending them a note. That helps OMs build circuits.

We have a more difficult test when members say they don't want to send to certain countries. Sometimes their reason is because of postage costs and sometimes the objection is political.

The next member to whom you will send the circuit is ordinarily someone who has requested covers from you country. Therefore it defeats the purpose of the CCCC when a member will not send to certain countries. Some OMs have told me they will not include those members on any circuits.

The lists given to OMs will continue to note members who wish to limit their sending, but we must remember that by vetoing some countries you will probably be limiting the circuits you will receive.
