Covers or Stamps?

From the notes which I received from CCCC members I have learned that we have three overlapping types of members. The differences are primarily about what we find most important in our collecting.

1st we have those who honor beautiful covers. Often the stamps are part of an artistic design including with superb artwork and layout design.

2nd we have country collectors. Frequently they desire at least one cover from every postal authority in the world. That's ambitious and difficult as some countries are very elusive.

3rd we have pure stamp collectors who often desire only the most recent stamp issues. Sometimes they are FDC fans and sometimes we know that the stamps will quickly go from covers into albums.

This means that your covers need to remember all 3 of these audiences. Remember what others want so that you will receive what you want.
