Cheaper Stamps?

Cover and stamp collectors grumble about increasing postage costs. Increases such as Australia's recent domestic rate jump from 70 cents to a dollar are frequent.

But on April 10 the United States postage rate will decrease for the first time in almost a century. The domestic letter rate will drop from \$.49 to \$.47, and the overseas rate from \$1.20 to \$1.15. Now as in 1919 the decrease is the result of the ending of a temporary surcharge.

Because almost all US stamps are now nondenominated "forever" stamps no new stamps will be issued. The most common pattern for USA covers to other countries will continue to be two "forever" domestic rate stamps plus a "forever" extra ounce stamp. What was .49+.49+.22 will now be .47+.47+.21.

Will cheaper stamps produce more circuits?
Let us hope so.
