Mint or Uncanceled

Some of the mail which we receive arrives without the stamps being cancel as they are used. Some members see this as a flaw. Others prefer the unmarked stamp.

The cancellation and other auxiliary markings show the history of a cover as it travels. The study of postal history often depends on these markings.

On the other hand, sometimes a cover is defaced by excessive marking. We occasionally receive cover where the stamps and even the address are all but concealed. That might be interesting at times, but it is always ugly.

You do your fellow collectors a favor when you request a neat hand cancel on your covers. Most postal employees do a nice job when asked. Often the high-speed mechanical cancellation machines not only have an uninteresting mark but may damage covers.

Make the extra effort to see that your covers receive an elegant cancellation.
