Stamps and Stickers

What is a collectable stamp? The simplest answer is that it is any stamp which we collect. But the variety issued by postal authorities is almost endless.

Many collectors prize definitive stamps which are the base currency for post offices. Many more collectors desire commemorative stamps. Do you want stamps showing people or scenery? Would you like history? What is your choice?
