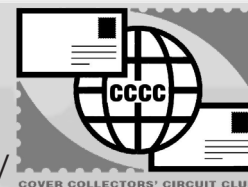

Rating Our Circuits

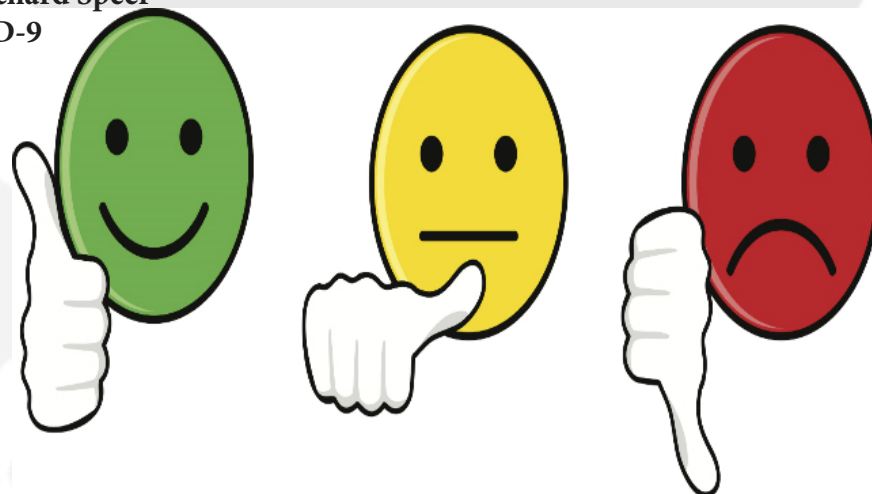
We all want nice covers. OMs rely on your reports of cover quality in planning new circuits. The standards for covers are on the reverse of each circuit.
