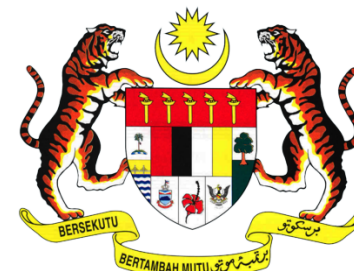
As for food, there are some restaurants that serve fairly good European style meals.
